




Year-Over-Year Non Farm Job Growth/Decline Columbia Gorge


12-Month Moving Average Non Farm Job Growth/Decline Columbia Gorge


Columbia Gorge Total Non Farm Employment, 2001 - 2017


Columbia Gorge Manufacturing Industry Employment, 2001 - 2017








### **Hood River County 2016 Average Wage by Industry**






### **Wasco County 2016 Average Wage by Industry**




### Klickitat County 2016 Average Wage by Industry






### Skamania County 2016 Average Wage by Industry






