Mid-Columbia Center for Living Project

Wasco County received a grant to support Mid-Columbia Center for Living (MCCFL) in the construction of a 22,639 square foot mental health facility. MCCFL provides treatment and services for 1,600 low- to moderate-income adults, children and families dealing with mental illness, addictions and/or developmental disabilities. They were outgrowing their facilities consisting of two leased and one owned building, all of which were substandard facilities due to age and layout. The new building includes space to consolidate MCCFL's programs and administration.
